#### 4. How We Collect Your Data

We collect information:

• directly from you (in person, online forms, email, phone) • through tenancy applications • via our website and cookies • through referencing partners (Let Alliance) • from property portals (Rightmove) • from public sources (e.g., Land Registry) • from landlords and tenants when necessary • via maintenance platforms and contractors

## 5. Lawful Basis for Processing

We process personal data under the following lawful bases:

### Contract

- To provide services including:
- tenant-find
- rent collection
- full property management
- tenancy referencing and approval
- drafting tenancy agreements
- carrying out repairs and arranging contractors
- handling deposits

#### **Legal Obligation**

To comply with:

- Right-to-Rent legislation
- Anti-money laundering requirements
- HMRC reporting rules
- Housing, safety and property compliance regulations

#### **Legitimate Interests**

For purposes including:

- preventing fraud
- ensuring tenancy suitability
- managing and improving services
- marketing to existing customers
- protecting our business and property assets

#### 6. How We Use Your Personal Data

We use personal data to:

- perform Right-to-Rent checks
- manage rents and client accounts
- communicate with landlords and tenants arrange repairs, inspections and safety checks market available properties comply with legal obligations improve our website and services

#### 7. Who We Share Your Data With

• Rightmove – for advertising and enquiries

#### Maintenance providers:

• Approved contractors (e.g., electricians, plumbers, gas engineers)

Professional services:

• Accountants, legal advisers, insurers

#### Government and regulatory bodies:

- HMRC
- Local authorities
- The Home Office (Right-to-Rent compliance)

## Marketing tools:

- Email and SMS marketing platforms
- Social media and advertising systems

We only share what is necessary and ensure all partners comply with data protection law.

#### 8. International Data Transfers

We work with overseas landlords and may accept international tenant applications.

Where data is transferred outside the UK, we ensure appropriate safeguards, such as:

- adequacy decisions
- standard contractual clauses (SCCs)
- secure encrypted systems

## 9. How Long We Keep Your Data

We retain data only as long as necessary, typically:

- Tenancy records: 6 years after tenancy end
- Right-to-Rent documents: 1 year after tenancy ends
- Financial transactions: 6 years
- Marketing preferences: until consent is withdrawn Enquiry forms: up to 12 months
